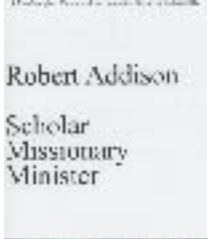


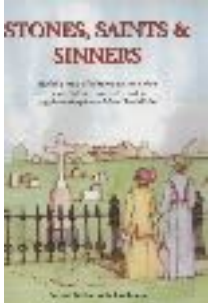
# Publications of St. Mark's Archives



**\$20 St. Mark's: Persons of Hopeful Piety** provides a history of the parish from 1790 to 2000. Fully illustrated paperback edition, 192 pages.

**\$15 Stones, Saints & Sinners (2nd ed.)** tours through the historic cemeteries of the Old Town as well as brief guided tours of the rural cemeteries. Coil-bound & fully illustrated, 178 pages.
