Burials at St. Mark's

All burial sites are reserved for the **members of St. Mark's Parish**. A member is a person who attends divine services, participates in parish activities, and contributes financially to the work of the parish.

St. Mark's Memorial Garden has spaces available for non-members.

All burials require a certificate of **interment rights** and a **death certificate and/or cremation certificate** as applicable.

All burials shall be conducted by a clergyman authorized by the Corporation of St. Mark's.

All burials in existing **family plots** require proof of ownership of the interment rights and letters of permission from existing family members who might also claim rights to burial in that family plot.

The basic cost of **Interment Rights** for a **Full Burial Lot** is \$3,000.00, payable to St. Mark's.

The cost of **Interment Rights** for a **Cremation Lot** is \$1,500.00. The lot is 7.5 square feet (3 x 2.5)

The cost of **opening a grave for full burial** is an additional cost and is payable by the rights holder to the funeral director.

The cost of **opening and closing a grave** for the interment of **cremated remains (in a small urn, box or loose)** is \$200.00. This fee applies to weekday interments and is payable to St. Mark's Cemetery. Burials may not be possible during winter months when the ground is frozen.

A maintenance fee of \$200.00 is payable to St. Mark's Cemetery at the time a full burial takes place.

The cost of **Interment Rights** for loose remains in the **Memorial Garden** is \$1,500.00. This fee includes the inscription of name and dates on a brass disc and on the wall plaque. Non-members will be charged an additional \$1,000.00.

No **monument** (base included) wider than twenty-four inches shall be allowed on a single lot. A fee is payable on installation.

Granite is the approved material for all markers and monuments.

The **design and inscription** on all monuments and markers must be approved by St. Mark's Cemetery Board to be in keeping with the dignity and decorum of St. Mark's Cemetery.

A fee is payable to St. Mark's Cemetery when a monument or marker is installed. The amount is prescribed by The Bereavement Authority of Ontario ("BAO") and is updated from time to time.
