The Rev. Canon David Thomas

The Rev. Canon David Thomas, a former rector of St. Mark's Anglican Church, died on Saturday, January 3, at age 91.

Canon David was rector of St. Mark's from 1979 to 1985. He was ordained to the priesthood in 1959 in Wales. He was welcomed to the Diocese of Niagara in 1970 and served as rector of several churches. He retired from full-time ministry in 1996. Since then, Canon David has primarily served as an honorary assistant at All Saints, Ridgeway.

His funeral will be held there on Saturday, January 17, at 11 a.m., with visitation at 10 a.m. Read his obituary here:
