In the Lutheran-Anglican-Moravian Cycle of Prayer: The Most Rev. Lynne McNaughton, Metropolitan, and the clergy and people of the Ecclesiastical Province of British Columbia and Yukon; The Assistant to the Bishop and staff of the British Columbia Synod; and remembering September 16 – 1741 – at a synod (legislative assembly) in London, the delegates determined that no human being would be the head of the church; by Lot, Jesus Christ was named as "Chief Elder of the Unitas Fratrum." Today, this day is celebrated by ordained servants renewing their ordination vows in a Cup of Covenant service.
